Excitement is building for the Seventh Annual Syracuse Catholic Women's Conference. This event will take place on October 29th 2016 at the Oncenter in Syracuse, N.Y. Pope Francis's proclamation a Jubilee Year of Mercy has inspired the theme of this year's conference, "Mercy is love in action". We look forward to again hosting close to 1000 women for a day of inspiration and fellowship. This year features some new and exciting developments as well as outstanding speakers.

The Conference will be held in the Exhibit Hall at the Oncenter. There are two price options for vendors on the registration form depending on their lunch option.

Option 1: \$200 includes one eight foot covered, draped table, admission and box lunch for two people.

Option 2: \$220 includes one eight foot covered draped table, admission and seated plated lunch for two people.

Optional electrical access is an additional \$50.

Vendors will have access to set up on Friday from 12:00-6:00pm, or starting at 6:30am on Saturday. Vendors need to be set and ready by 7:30am Saturday when doors open and registration begins. This earlier start time will allow for more shopping opportunity. The conference will begin at 9:00am with the keynote speaker. The event will conclude after 4:00pm Mass with Bishop Cunningham.

A vendor registration form is available on the website. New this year, payment can be made by mail with a check or online at www.SyracuseCatholicWomen.org. Table availability and placement are on a first come, first serve basis with receipt of your registration and payment.

Please note that book sales for Raymond Arroyo's books will be handled exclusively by the Women's Commission at the Conference to help offset costs of the conference. We appreciate your understanding by not offering books by Raymond Arroyo at the Conference.
